


Milliken Announces Competition Winners


The seven winning designs, selected from approximately 1,500 entries in Milliken's first annual Carpet and Rug Competition, were shown in Chicago during NEOCON X. Daniel Stark, Director of Style and Design at Milliken, presented the designers with the awards which carried cash prizes for the designers and cash grants for the recipient's designated art, design or architectural schools. The winning entries are being produced by Milliken in an 80/20 blend of wool/nylon and will become part of either the Magistrate contract line or the firm's area rug collection.
